Other happenings: One final Wine Social is scheduled for Nov. 11th. If interested in

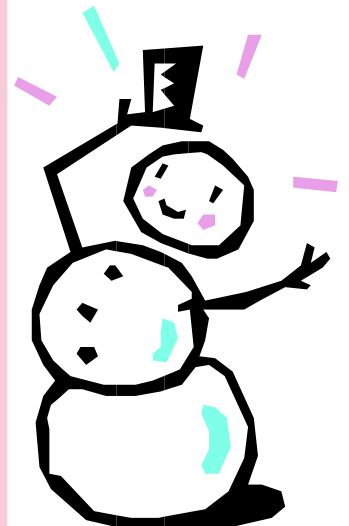

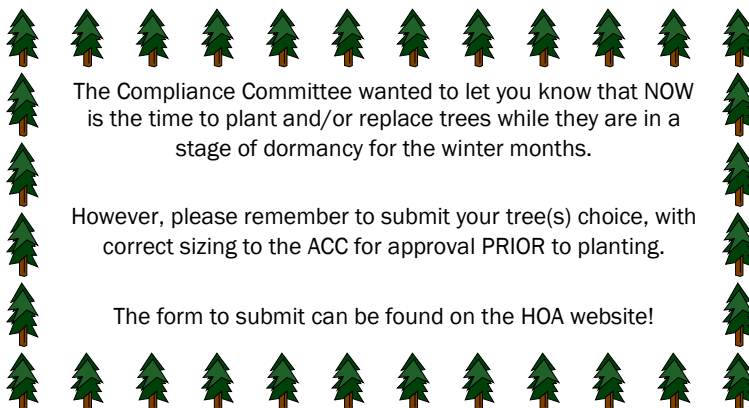
