Any and all homeowner's are welcome to join the committee. The more volunteers there are the more ideas, opportunities and options there will be available.


This calendar year the meetings will be on the First Monday of the month.

- Do not run your sprinklers in freezing conditions.
- Walk your pets on a leash.
- When walking/running/biking in the dark wear light colors or reflectors or carry a flashlight.

- Don't let your child(ren) play in the street.
